

**CONSTITUTION OF THE REPUBLIC OF SEYCHELLES
(NINTH AMENDMENT) BILL, 2018**

(Bill No. 23 of 2018)

OBJECTS AND REASONS

The Bill seeks to amend the Constitution of the Republic of Seychelles (Cap 42) in order to do away with the provision for payment of pension to the Chairperson of the Electoral Commission. The amendment is required to make the provision relating to the Chairperson of the Electoral Commission on par with the provisions relating to the Chairman of Constitutional Appointments Authority and the Chairman of the Public Service Appeal Board.

ENACTED by the President and the National Assembly.

1. This Act may be cited as the Constitution of the Republic of Seychelles (Ninth Amendment) Act, 2018. Short title

2. The Constitution of the Republic of Seychelles is amended in Article 115C, by repealing clause (4A).
