OBJECTS AND REASONS

This Bill seeks to provide for special pension to certain categories of public service officers.

Part I provides for the preliminary matters, namely the short title, interpretation and eligibility for special pension.

Part II provides for the categories entitled for special pension and the rate of special pension.

Part III provides for the management of special pension such as continuance in service, management of pension and application form and sanction of special pension.

Part IV provides for miscellaneous provisions such as life certificate, power to make regulations and schedules.

PART I - PRELIMINARY

1. This Act may be cited as the Public Service Special Short title Pension Act, 2017.

Interpretation

2. In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires —

"continuous service" means uninterrupted employment during the period provided that an interruption up to ninety days shall not be considered an interrupting continuous employment for the purpose of a claim for a special pension;

"Government Service" means paid service in a public office or any employment in respect of which a salary or wage is paid from the Consolidated Fund and for the purpose of this Act it includes Fire and Rescue Officers employed by the Seychelles Civil Aviation Authority;

"Life Certificate" means a certificate issued by a medical practitioner certifying that the person specified therein is alive on the date of issue of the certificate.

"Minister" means the Minister responsible for Public Administration;

"public officer" means a person employed in any of the profession or service specified in Schedule 1.

Eligibility for special pension

- 3. A public officer shall be eligible for special pension under this Act, if he or she—
 - (a) was in Government Service on 1st January, 2005;
 - (b) has 10 years' continuous service or 20 years' aggregate service in the profession and attained age of 60 years on the coming into force of this Act or on attaining the age of 60 years; and

(c) is not receiving a Government pension under the Pensions Act (Cap 159) or a public sector pension under the Public Sector Special Pension Act, 2005 (Act 9 of 2005) or any pension funded from Consolidated Funds.

PART II - ENTITLEMENT TO SPECIAL PENSION

4. The public officers specified in Schedule 1 who are citizens of Seychelles shall be entitled to the special pension.

Categories entitled for special pension

5.(1) The special pension shall be payable from 1st July, 2017.

Rate of special pension payable

- (2) The special pension shall be paid at a monthly rate of SCR1,000.
- (3) The amount of pension under subsection (2) shall be reviewed periodically taking into consideration the percentage increase in the retail price index in such manner as may be prescribed.

PART III - MANAGEMENT OF SPECIAL PENSION

6.(1) A public officer may continue in employment until they reach national retirement age under the Employment Act or the age to qualify for their pension under the Seychelles Pension Fund Act or Social Security Fund Act.

Continuance in employment

- (2) The special pension payable shall be irrespective of any retirement benefit paid by the Social Security Fund or the Seychelles Pension Fund.
- 7.(1) The scheme for special pension shall be managed by the Chief Secretary in the Department of Public Administration.

Management of pension

(2) An application for special pension under this Act shall be submitted to the Chief Secretary in the form set out in the Schedule.

Application form and sanction of special pension

- **8.**(1) The following documents shall accompany the application form—
 - (a) a certified copy of the applicant's birth certificate;
 - (b) a certified copy of the applicant's national identity card;
 - (c) an employment record held by the employing organisation; and
 - (d) the bank account details.
- (2) The Department of Public Administration may call for any further details or documents, as may be considered necessary for determining the applicant's eligibility for special pension, from the Department where the applicant was employed.
- (3) The Chief Secretary of the Department of Public Administration shall sanction the special pension if the applicant is found eligible.

PART IV - MISCELLANEOUS

Life certificate 9. A pensioner shall produce a Life Certificate to the Department of Public Administration every six months.

Regulations

- 10.(1) The Minister may make regulations for carrying into effect provisions of this Act.
- (2) Without prejudice to the generality of subsection (1) the regulations may provide for
 - (a) revision of pension; or
 - (b) any other matter which may be required to be prescribed.

(3) The Minister may by regulations amend the Schedules.
