**EXPLANATORY STATEMENT OF OBJECTS AND REASONS
FOR THE BILL**

This Bill, pursuant to Article 154 (7) of the Constitution, seeks to provide for the appropriation of the sum of four hundred and seventy-three million, one hundred thousand, six hundred and ninety-three rupees and eighty-seven cents (SCR473,100,693.87), as specified in the supplementary estimate and approved by the resolution of the National Assembly on Tuesday 8th October 2024, to regularise the expenditure incurred in 2024.

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE PURPOSES OF A SUPPLEMENTARY ESTIMATE APPROVED BY THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY.

ENACTED BY THE PRESIDENT AND THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY.

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation Act, 2025.

Appropriation of Expenditure

2. The sum not exceeding four hundred and seventy-three million, one hundred thousand, six hundred and ninety-three rupees and eighty-seven cents (SCR473,100,693.87) specified in the supplementary estimate and approved by the resolution of the National Assembly on Tuesday 8th October, 2024 is hereby appropriated from the Consolidated Fund for the purposes specified in the supplementary estimate.
